What does UHSEP offer?

- Over 100 hours of math, science, and language instruction
- Individual tutoring to support instruction
- Presentations from health professionals

Student Expectations

- Participants must commit to the full five-week program plus one day orientation
- Participants are required to live on the UNM campus.
- Participants may not bring their own vehicles.
- Participants must comply with campus policies regarding conduct, academic honesty, and lawful behavior.

Student Eligibility

- New Mexico resident with a valid SSN or ITIN (for stipend purposes)
- Interest in pursuing a health career
- Minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale
- Incoming College Freshmen
- Have been accepted to, and entering a post-secondary college/university.
